



Transportation Board Holds Route 4 West Rutland Public Hearing

The Vermont Transportation Board pursuant to 19 V.S.A. § 1708(b) will hold a public hearing at 6 p.m. on August 11, 2016 in the Town Hall Conference Room at 35 Marble Street in West Rutland to review a request from the Town of West Rutland for a break in the Limited Access of Route 4.

While the proposal does not seek an actual highway connection to Route 4, the proposal does seek to construct a break in the Limited Access Highway right-of-way adjacent to the Exit 6 eastbound off-ramp in West Rutland. This access would not directly connect to the ramp, but instead would intersect with a town highway (Boardman Hill Road) at a location near the off-ramp that falls within the Route 4 Limited Access right-of way.

The purpose of the proposal is to allow the town to improve traffic flow to and from the West Rutland Recreational Area at 294 Fairview Ave. The town, at the hearing, will make a presentation regarding the proposal.
